Today, the campus features **90,000 square feet of shared lab facilities**, making it the **largest shared wet lab hub in the United States as of June 2022**, and the **largest shared workspace facility in the region**. Designed to foster collaboration and accelerate growth, CIC Philadelphia supports a thriving community of life sciences and technology companies working to bring new innovations to market.

Founded in 1999 in Cambridge, Massachusetts, CIC (Cambridge Innovation Center) is a global innovation campus operator that supports startups, scale-ups, corporations, and public organizations working to solve complex global challenges. CIC provides flexible office space, fully equipped laboratories, and collaborative programming designed to help innovators grow, connect, and accelerate their ideas.

Today, CIC manages more than **1.5 million square feet of workspace, labs, and event space** across North America, Europe, and Asia, serving thousands of entrepreneurs and organizations worldwide.
